LO'T Staff Editorial

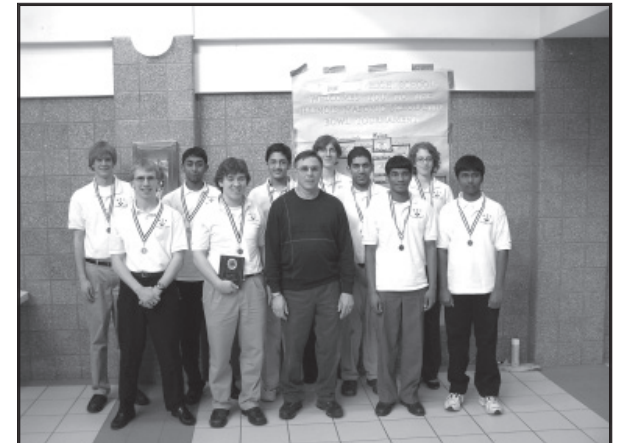
