MEAL CHARGES

In accordance with state and federal law, the Moline-Coal Valley School District practices the following standard to ensure District employees, families and students have a shared understanding of expectations regarding meal charges. This standard practice allows for our students to receive the nutrition they need during the school day, prevents identification of any students with insufficient funds to pay for meals, and it maintains the financial integrity of the nonprofit school nutrition program.

Meal Service

The District operates under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), and makes school meals available to all students. Through the NSLP, the cost of school meals are free, reduced or paid, depending on your household's eligibility. To determine if your student is eligible to receive free or reduced price meals, please fill out an application at your student's school.

Payment of Meals

Each student has use of a meal account. Funds may be added to student meal accounts online via Skyward Family Access, or by submitting a check or cash to the office of your student's school. School Meal prices are posted on the District website under 'Parents & Students', then the 'School Fees' tab.

Negative Account Balances

The District will make reasonable efforts to notify families when meal account balances are low or negative. Parents/Guardians may also login to Skyward Family Access to check account balances at any time. Additionally, when an account reaches a negative balance equivalent to the cost of five lunches, the District will make reasonable efforts to collect unpaid meal charges classified as delinquent debt. The District will coordinate communications with families to resolve the matter of unpaid charges. Students with negative balances will not be denied meals, however, they can be prohibited from charging "extras" or a-la-carte items.

Communication of this Practice

The standard regarding meal charges shall be provided in writing to:

- All households at the beginning of each school year;
- Students and families who transfer into the District at time of transfer; and
- All staff responsible for enforcing any aspect of the standard.
